• The fourth-largest city in Poland and the MES largest in the west of the country

**BRIDGE** 

- With a community numbering over 630,000 inhabitants
- It lies across the Oder river and four tributaries, and as many as 12 islands are to be found within its boundaries – it is crisscrossed by over 100 bridges.
