Why Bridge and Fencing together?

Both disciplines develop through related and complementary paths.

It is rather restrictive to think only at features as concentration, strategy, tactics, reaction time, ability to anticipate the opponent's moves in a few seconds, psychological strength.

In fact, synergies between the two disciplines are many, and can be identified in the teaching and training approach. Generally, an athlete, in order to be able to achieve his full potential, should reach his highest fitness level together with an excellent state of mind.

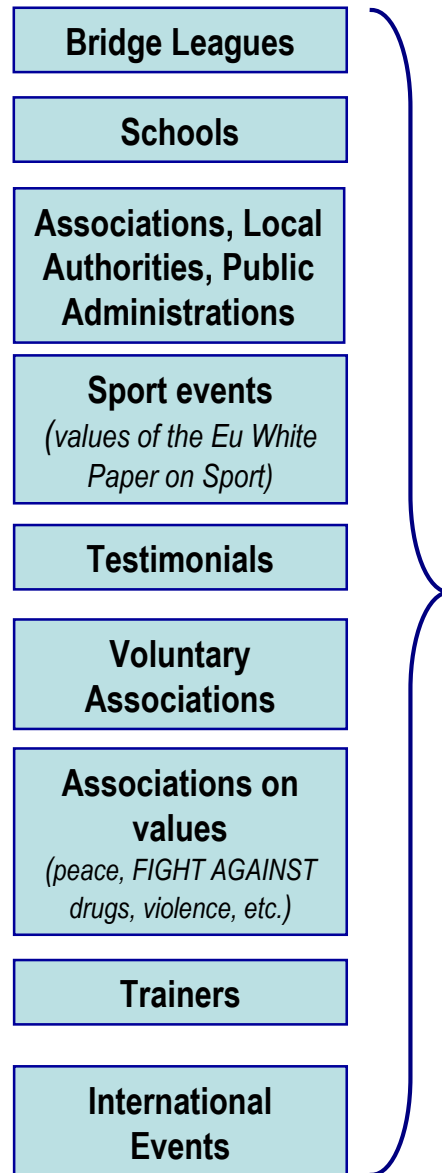

CSCS2020 : the project

CSCS2020 consists in the organisation of a sport event on Mind Sports Bridge & Fencing, and in the creation of a community of young people on the basis of values such as friendship, integrity, solidarity, inclusion, contained in the EU White Paper on Sport.

The event will take place in Rome, at the Olympic training centre “G. Onesti”, since the 24th April until the 3rd May 2015, and it will represent the final stage of a training and qualification process, developed over the entire year.

Every participating country will identify a boarding school, engaged with «dual careers», where federal instructors, duly selected, will present theoretical and practical training modules about Bridge & Fencing, which will allow to organise local tournaments to qualify for the final competitions. Every country will then send 6 athletes to Rome, where tournaments will be held for the duathlon (Bridge & Fencing).

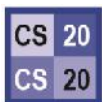

CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT is made on January 31 2014

BETWEEN

Federazione Italiana Gioco Bridge

AND

European Bridge League

AND

The Parties listed in Annex I

relating to the Project entitled «**Cerebrum Sanum in Corpore Sano 2015**»

WHEREAS:

- a) The Annex is an integral part of the Agreement.
- b) The Parties intend to submit a Proposal for a Project entitled «**Cerebrum Sanum in Corpore Sano 2015**» to the European Commission referring to the **Call of proposal 2013 EAC/S11/13** in the Erasmus + Programme (deadline: 14 March 2014).
- c) The Agreement is intended to define the functional and organisational rules and tasks of the Parties.
- d) The Agreement shall become effective upon its signature by the Parties and shall expire or terminate with the end of Project activities.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Coordinator for the Project is **European Bridge League**
- 2. The **European Bridge League** (hereinafter EBL) will be responsible of Parties' relations concerning operational issues about the implementation of the Project.
- 3. Each Party shall identify a contact person for managing the relationships between all the Parties involved.
- 4. The Parties shall:
 - check the compliance with the Programme Criteria regarding to the articles 106 and 107 of the EU Financial Regulation, the financial capacity and the operational capacity;
 - register to Participant portal in order to complete all the information and to upload all the declarations and documents required by the application form;
 - co-operate in providing all the information for the submission of the application form;

5. The Parties shall take cognizance that, in case of EU grant awarded, will involve in the realization of activities that will be described in the Project «**Cerebrum Sanum in Corpore Sano 2015**» such as training activities, support in the organization of the final event and dissemination activities;
6. The Parties shall take cognizance that according to Erasmus + Programme Guide, the EU grant will cover up maximum 80% of the total eligible costs (personnel, travel and subsistence, equipment, consumable and supplies, duties, taxes and charges, other costs and indirect costs);
7. The Parties shall treat as confidential all information or documents received and/or produced and/or exchanged. The data and the information shall not be disseminated (i.e. personal data shall not be disclosed to unidentified entities, in any form whatsoever, including by making available or interrogating such data) apart from their own personnel involved in the processing of the data provided.
















