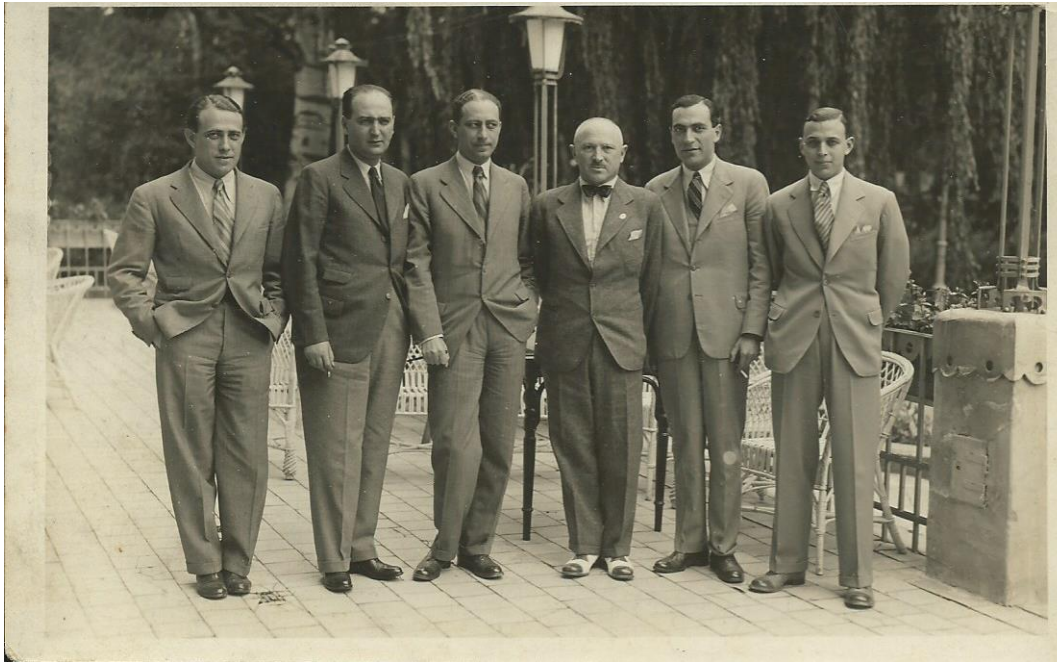
The Hungarian Bridge history
