Discuss outcome briefly – good or not quite so good results

Liepaja - partnership understanding

NEXT To make life of coach easier....

Pairs produce exercise problems.

Each pair suggests on paper a bidding situation where the last bid should be "difficult".

Separate partners physically in room

All situations are listed on the wall (whiteboard)

Each player writes his interpretation of the bidding situations **created by the other pairs.**

Partners reunite

Partners compare their answers within the pair.

Take one point for each "right" (same) answer.

For a wrong answer, give one point to the creator.

Find out who won.

Give them an applause.
