Dear Presidents, dear Friends,

I am very pleased to confirm that the 54th European Bridge Team Championships will be held at **Kursaal Oostende** (Sea Promenade)

6th to 16th June 2018

Format of the Championships

The Team Championships consist of 3 Series: Open, Women and Seniors.

All 3 Championships will be played as a single complete round robin. The number of boards played in each match will be determined and published when the number of participants is known. The Open Championship will be played over 11 days, and the Women's Championship and Seniors Championship will be played over 7 days.

For the Women and Seniors National Pairs, It is anticipated that each Championship will consist of two stages: a Qualifying Stage, and a Final Stage (Final A and Final B). However, should the number of participants permit, there will be a one stage all-play-all (Endless Howell) competition. Details of the competitions may be changed according to the final registration of participants.

Registration of Teams

All entries to the Championships tournaments must be submitted electronically, via the EBL website -available at the beginning of December- (not by email) at

- Deadline is 25th April 2018 (It is very important to respect this deadline).

Right to enter

Each member NBO, being up to date with the payment of its annual dues (including the 2018 dues) to the E.B.L. is authorised to enter one team in the Open Series, one team in the Women's Series and one team in the Seniors' Series of the Championships. Countries must have paid the entry fee and be up to date with the payment of the dues to the EBL before they can participate in the Championships.

Each participating member NBO must play against all other participating member NBOs. Entry and subsequent refusal to play will result in disqualification.

Every proposed player must, along with other criteria, satisfy the EBL Eligibility rules and each team composition submitted by a NBO will be examined by the Credentials Committee.

To participate in the Seniors Series a player must have been born in 1957 or earlier.

Competitor's Commitment form

Attention is drawn to Article 2.8 of the EBL GCoC. Players, Captains, Coaches and other Team Officials in Teams Championships are required to have signed the EBL Competitor's Commitment Form (see GCoC Appendix 2) before the start of the event.

Entry Fees

The entry fees are € 3,500 for the Open and € 3,250 for the Women & Senior Teams. A discount will be given to NBOs who did not participate in any of the last three EBL Team Championships held in Dublin 2012, Opatija 2014 and Budapest 2016: for these teams the entry fees are € 2,500 for the Open and € 2,000 for the Women & Senior Teams.

Note: Any players requiring exemption certificates should ensure that the Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE) Application Form is fully completed, together with the necessary supporting documents (see what is required at www.wada-ama.org/en/science-medical) and return it to the address given on the document as soon as possible and no later than 30 days before the commencement of the competition in which you are participating. It is acceptable to scan and email the TUE form and documentation.
