#### **EUROPEAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

1997	Full Round Robin, 14 days in Open, 10 days in Women and 7
	days in Seniors.
2001	Seniors increased to 10 days.
2004	Both Open and Women 13 days.
2006	Women only 8 days.
2008	Open split into 2 groups Round Robin first week, only top 9 in
	each group played a new Round Robin the second week.
2010	Open reduced to 11 days by avoiding repeat encounters.
2016	Open reverted to a full Round Robin. Women's National Pairs
	re-introduced prior start of their Teams event.
2018	Seniors' National Pairs is being introduced.



#### **EUROPEAN TRANSNATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- 5 days Mixed Teams. 3 days Mixed Pairs. Open, Women and 2003 Senior Teams and Pairs each 5 days. Teams qualifying in small groups. Old "Masters" allowed straight into Pairs finals. Mixed Pairs 4 days and Open Pairs 6 days. 2007 Women and Senior Teams and Pairs both increased to 6 days. 2011 2013 Many major changes. No more allowing "Masters" directly into finals. Teams qualifying by Swiss. Shortening some events, avoiding "drop-ins" into finals. Introducing daily teams and pairs side events. Drastically shortening the Women and Senior events due to low participation.
- 2015 One day added to Team events.



#### **CHAMPIONS' CUP**

2003 8 teams playing 1 day RR in 2 groups and 2 days KO.

2004 Increased to 12 teams as today. Cash prizes provided by the host NBO.

2014 Qualifying by a full RR.

2016 Cash prizes discontinued.
