Who can be nominated?

They must be alive!

All living players of NBOs within the EBL are eligible



Who can nominate players?

Only NBOs affiliated to EBL can propose their own members – maximum of three nominees per year



Proposals should include – Reasons for recommendation

Medals won in EBL or WBF events

Other notable achievements

Volunteer work with Juniors

Publications etc



Proposals will be considered by - Current HOF Inductees

EBL President

EBL EC HOF Chairman

Chairman and Members of Players Advisory Committee

IBPA President



Each of the Electors will receive the list of nominees submitted.

They may vote for up to three candidates, not more than one per NBO

The three nominees receiving the most votes, providing no NBO has more than one candidate, will be submitted to the EBL Executive Committee for approval



Counting and Weighting of Votes will be conducted by the Chairman of the HOF Committee



This year's process will commence with notifications to all NBOs next week.

Nominations should be received by 17

March – St Patrick's Day

The names will be submitted to the EBL EC meeting in early April
