Dear Presidents, dear Friends,

We are very pleased to confirm that the 15th European National and Transnational Youth Pairs Championships will be held at the Conference Centre NH Koningshof -Locht 117, 5504 RM Veldhoven.

The event will be a European Youth national pairs championship combined with transnational championship and will be **open to all players (worldwide**) with a transnational format as explained below.

Format

- ✓ The championship will include participants from five series: U31, U26 Open, U26 Women, U21 and U16.
- ✓ The first two days will include a Mixed pairs tournament with a parallel IMP Pairs.
- ✓ The EBL Open pairs championship will be organised over the next three days.
- ✓ The exact format will be decided according to the registration in each age category.
- ✓ The players will be using a digital bidding box on Lovebridge tablets



Eligibility

- ✓ All tournaments are open to all players from all over the world.
- ✓ Transnational pairs will be permitted to participate in all tournaments (two players from different countries).
- ✓ The events will include ranking and Medals for both the EBL National title and **Total** ranking of all participants.
- ✓ In order to win an EBL National title, both European players should be from the same country.

Right of entry

Bridge players (registered members of WBF NBOs), in good standing with their Federation and born on 1st January 1993 or later (U31 Series) and on 1st January 1998 or later (U26 & U26Women) and on 1st January 2003 or later (U21) and on 1st January 2008 or later (U16) are entitled to participate. **there will be** NO age restriction exemptions for this EBL event and there will be no restrictions on numbers of entries per NBO.

Mixed / IMP pairs: all mixed pairs are expected playing together but at the end of the competition the top total ranked will be awarded with EBL medals plus trophies to the 1st U21 pair and the 1st U16 pair.

NBOs must have paid the entry fee and be up to date with the payment of dues (including 2023 dues) to the EBL/WBF before their players can participate in the Championships.

The entry fees for the Transnational pairs may be paid by the NBOs or the players themselves.

In any case participants must be nominated by their NBO and all such nominations are subject to authorisation by the EBL Credentials Committee.

Registration of Pairs

The registrations of pairs for all the series **must be made by the Federation.** Transnational Pairs may be registered by the players. All entries to the Championships tournaments **must be submitted electronically, via the EBL website (not by email) starting end of March** at

- Deadline is 25th June 2023 (It is very important to respect this deadline).

Entry Fees

- ✓ Mixed Pairs & IMP Pairs = 100€ (50€ for a pair consisting of one U16 + one other, and no fee for two U16)
- ✓ U31, U26, U26Women & U21 Pairs = 150€
- ✓ U16 and the President's Cup = no entry fee

EBL Youth coach seminar

- ✓ Following the success of the previous Youth Coach Seminars, these Championships will again include a two-day Youth Coach Seminar.
- ✓ The EBL will cover 3 nights of accommodation for EBL's NBO's officials (arrival on the 27th and departure on the 30th July).
- ✓ The Seminar is free of charge with a maximum of two participants per NBO; participants only pay for their travel.
